

Motor Insurers Database.

As a result of the 4th EU Motor Insurers Directive you are required to provide Motor Insurers Database (MID) with the make / model, registration numbers of all vehicles that are owned by you and that will be driven, used or parked on a road or public place. This includes:

1. All vehicles permanently owned by you.
2. Stock vehicles taxed and in your possession for more than 14 days for the purpose of sale.
3. Vehicles driven under Trade Plate regulations. You must also disclose Trade Plate numbers.

All changes must be notified within 5 working days of the change occurring. Please use the form below to inform us of all vehicles currently in your possession that have not been declared on the proposal form.

Warning – This is a legal obligation and failure to supply the information and keep it up to date is a criminal offence. The maximum penalty, if convicted, for non compliance is a fine of £5000.00 the MIIC will be seeking prosecution of non compliant policyholders

It should be noted that a Motor Trade Road Risks policy does not provide cover for all vehicles or every eventuality and the submission of this information should **NOT** be regarded as an acceptance on the part of the insurer that cover applies in respect of information being disclosed.
